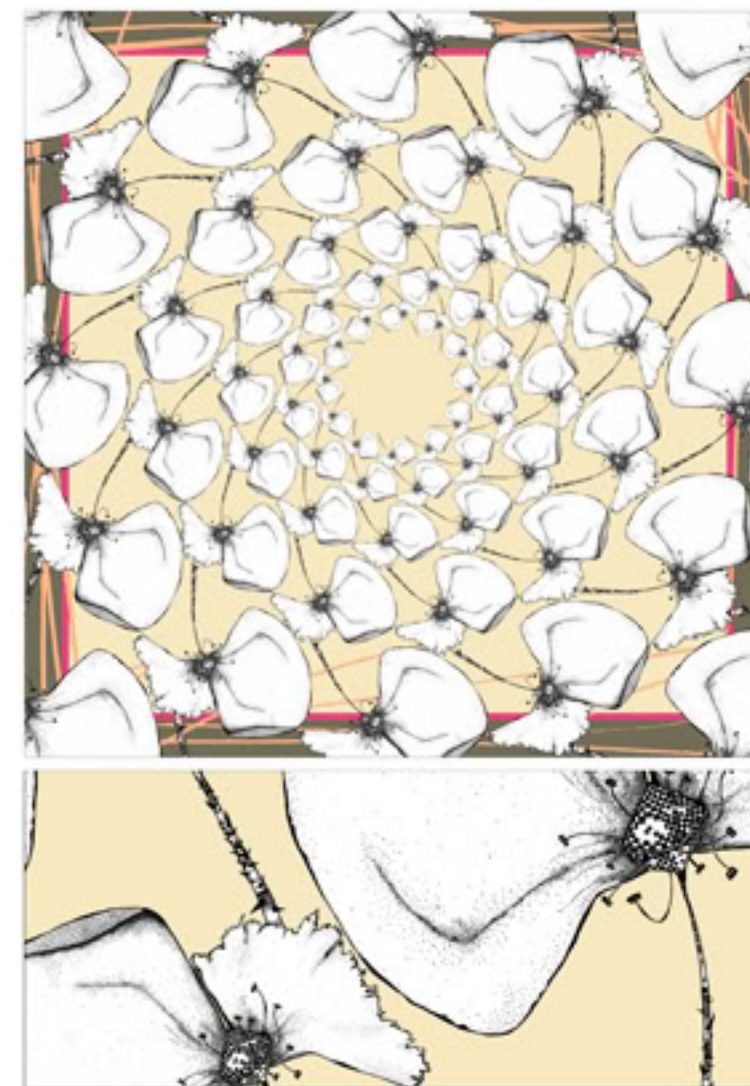
Wrapped Up for Christmas - Devon Guild of Craftsmen annual Christmas exhibition is back for its sixth year
